**The Parking Places (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) (Amendment
No. 6) Order (Northern Ireland) 2013**

Made - - - - - *15th October 2013*

Coming into operation - *4th November 2013*

The Department for Regional Development(**a**) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Articles 10(4), 13(1) and (16) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997(**b**) and now vested in it(**c**).

It appears to the Department to be necessary to provide suitable parking places for vehicles on the lengths of the roads specified in the Schedule.

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 4 to the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

The Department in compliance with paragraph 3(4) of that Schedule, has taken such other steps as appear to the Department reasonably practicable for the purpose of bringing specifically to the knowledge of the occupiers of land adjacent to the parking places the particulars specified in paragraph 3(2) of that Schedule.

No written objections or other representations have been received.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Parking Places (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) (Amendment No. 6) Order (Northern Ireland) 2013 and shall come into operation on 4th November 2013.

Amendments

2.—(1) Schedule 1 to The Parking Places (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) Order (Northern Ireland) 2006(a) shall be amended in accordance with paragraphs (2) and (3).

(2) Delete the following items—

- (a) item no. 162 relating to Edenderry Road, Banbridge; and
- (b) item no. 820 relating to Ponsonby Avenue, Belfast.

(3) Add the items set out in the Schedule to this Order.

3.—(1) Schedule 1 to The Parking Places on Roads (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) Order (Northern Ireland) 2006(b) shall be amended in accordance with paragraphs (2) and (3).

(2) Delete the following items—

- (a) item no. 35 relating to Drumbreda Crescent, Armagh;
- (b) item no. 963 relating to Grattan Street, Lurgan;
- (c) item no. 1169 relating to Jordanstown Road, Newtownabbey; and
- (d) item no. 1419 relating to Dromore Street, Rathfriland.

(3) For item no. 678 substitute the following item—

“Prince's Street, Dromore, County Down (north-west side) - from a point 16 metres south-west of its junction with Cross Lane, for a distance of 6 metres in a south-westerly direction.”.

SCHEDULE

Article 2 (3)

Unlimited Waiting

- “955. Cregagh Gardens, Armagh (east side) – from a point 120 metres south of its junction with Monaghan Road, for a distance of 3 metres in a southerly direction.
- 956. Drumbreda Avenue, Armagh (north-west side, to the side of No. 22 Drumbreda Gardens) – from a point 163 metres north-east of its junction with Drumbreda Walk, for a distance of 6 metres in a north-westerly direction.
- 957. Grange Park, Ballygawley (south-west side of the build-out facing No. 24) – from a point 2.4 metres north-west of the south-east end of the build-out extending for a distance of 2.6 metres in an north-westerly direction.
- 958. Cullingtree Road, Belfast (north-west side) – from a point 51 metres north-east of its junction with Grosvenor Road, for a distance of 6.6 metres in a north-easterly direction.
- 959. Forthriver Park, Belfast (north-west side) – from a point 32 metres south-west of its junction with Forthriver Road, for a distance of 5.5 metres in a south-westerly direction.
- 960. Hillside Terrace, Benburb (west side) – from a point 70 metres north of Carrick View, for a distance of 6 metres in a northerly direction.
- 961. Main Street, Beragh (north side) – from a point 55 metres west of its junction with Fountain Street, for a distance of 6.5 metres in a westerly direction.
- 962. Bridge Street, Castledawson (south-west side) – from a point 14.5 metres north of its junction with Main Street, for a distance of 6.5 metres in a north-westerly direction.
- 963. Woodland Drive, Newtownabbey (north-east side, to the front of Beechwood House) – from a point 63 metres north-east of its junction with Woodland Crescent, for a distance of 7 metres in an easterly direction.
- 964. Rosconnor Place, Rathfriland (south-east side) – from a point 23 metres south-west of its junction with Downpatrick Street, for a distance of 6 metres in a south-westerly direction.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends The Parking Places (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) Order (Northern Ireland) 2006 and The Parking Places on Roads (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) Order (Northern Ireland) 2006.

The amendments provide for the introduction of parking places with unlimited waiting on the lengths of the road specified in the Schedule, the amendment of the item specified in Article 3(3) and the removal of the parking places referred to in Articles 2(2) and 3(2).
