**The U232 Aghafad Road (Rubble Road), Newtownstewart
(Abandonment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2014**

Made - - - - - *21st May 2014*

Coming into operation - *1st July 2014*

The Department for Regional Development^(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 68(1) of the Roads (Northern Ireland) Order 1993^(b) and now vested in it^(c).

The Department in accordance with Article 68(4) of that Order is of the opinion that another road is available which provides alternative facilities for road traffic.

Notice has been published, served and displayed in compliance with paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 8 to that Order.

No objection has been received.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The U232 Aghafad Road (Rubble Road), Newtownstewart (Abandonment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2014 and shall come into operation on 1st July 2014.

Application

2. The length of road described in the Schedule is abandoned.

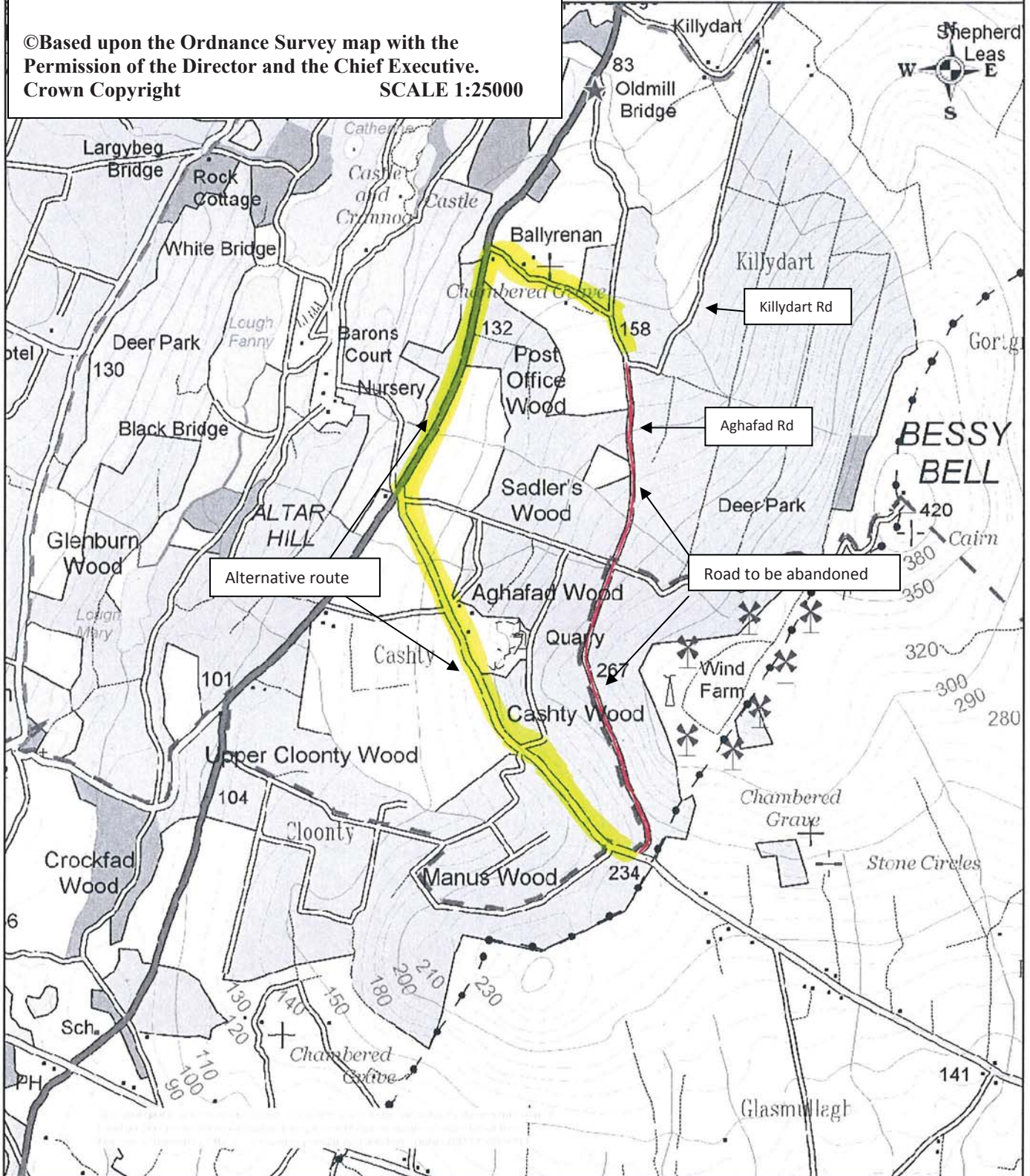
