**The Parking Places on Roads (Electric Vehicles) (Amendment
No. 3) Order (Northern Ireland) 2014**

Made - - - - - *30th September 2014*

Coming into operation - - - - - *21st October 2014*

The Department for Regional Development(**a**) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Articles 10(4) and 13(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997(**b**) and now vested in it(**c**).

It appears to the Department to be necessary to provide suitable parking places for electric vehicles on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule.

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 4 to the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

The Department, in compliance with paragraph 3(4) of that Schedule, has taken such other steps as appear to the Department reasonably practicable for the purpose of bringing specifically to the knowledge of the occupiers of land adjacent to the parking places the particulars specified in paragraph 3(2) of that Schedule.

No written objection or other representation has been received.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Parking Places on Roads (Electric Vehicles) (Amendment No. 3) Order (Northern Ireland) 2014 and shall come into operation on 21st October 2014.

Amendment

2. The Parking Places on Roads (Electric Vehicles) Order (Northern Ireland) 2012(**d**) shall be amended by the substitution for the Schedule of the Schedule set out in the Schedule to this Order.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order amends the Parking Places (Electric Vehicles) Order (Northern Ireland) 2012 by the substitution of the Schedule by the Schedule set out in this Order which adds parking for places for electric vehicles at Chapel Road, Dungiven; Church Street, Kilrea, Catherine Street, Limavady; Lower Landsdowne Road, Portrush and Market Street, Tandragee and clarifies the operation at all times of existing parking places for electric vehicles.

A penalty charge (£90) is payable with respect to a vehicle involved in a contravention of the parking places Order in accordance with the Traffic Management (Northern Ireland) Order 2005 and The Penalty Charges (Prescribed Amounts) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006.
