The Belfast Road, Carrickfergus (Part-Time 20mph Speed Limit) Order (Northern Ireland) 2016

Made - - - - 18th October 2016

Coming into operation - 8th November 2016

The Department for Infrastructure(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 38(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997(b) and now vested in it(c).

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 5 to that Order.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

No written objection or other representation has been received.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Belfast Road, Carrickfergus (Part-Time 20mph Speed Limit) Order (Northern Ireland) 2016 and shall come into operation on 8th November 2016.

Part-time speed limit

- **2.**—(1) A person shall not drive a motor vehicle on the length of road specified in the Schedule at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour when such speed limit applies to that length of road in accordance with paragraph (2).
- (2) A 20 miles per hour speed limit applies to the length of road specified in the Schedule when a 20 miles per hour speed limit is indicated by means of a traffic sign prescribed in Diagram 670 of the Traffic Signs Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1997(**d**).

SCHEDULE

Article 2

PART-TIME SPEED LIMIT

Belfast Road, Route A2, Carrickfergus, from a point 180 metres north-east of its junction with Windmill Avenue, Unclassified No. 3102, to a point 210 metres south-west of that junction.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order introduces a part-time speed limit on the length of road specified in the Schedule. The Order permits the current 40 miles per hour speed limit on the length of road adjacent to the Model Primary School, Carrickfergus to be reduced to 20 miles per hour, when a 20 miles per hour limit is indicated by a traffic sign.
