**The Parking Places (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) (Amendment
No. 4) Order (Northern Ireland) 2020**

Made - - - - - *19th November 2020*

Coming into operation - - - - - *10th December 2020*

The Department for Infrastructure^(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Articles 10(4), 13(1) and (16) of, and paragraph 5 of Schedule 4 to, the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997^(b) and now vested in it^(c).

It appears to the Department to be necessary to provide suitable parking places for vehicles on the lengths of the roads specified in the Schedule and in Article 2(3).

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 4 to the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

The Department in compliance with paragraph 3(4) of that Schedule, has taken such other steps as appear to the Department reasonably practicable for the purpose of bringing specifically to the knowledge of the occupiers of land adjacent to the parking places the particulars specified in paragraph 3(2) of that Schedule.

Two objections have been received and duly considered and no other representations have been received.

The Department has modified the draft Order.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Parking Places (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) (Amendment No. 4) Order (Northern Ireland) 2020 and shall come into operation on 10th December 2020.

Amendments

2.—(1) The Parking Places (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) Order (Northern Ireland) 2016^(a) is amended in accordance with paragraphs (2) and (3).

(2) In Schedule 1—

(a) Delete the following—

- (i) item no. 226 relating to Broadway, Ballywalter;
- (ii) item no. 1034 relating to Main Street, Dundrum;
- (iii) item no. 1276 relating to Killyglen Road, Larne; and
- (iv) item no. 2467 relating to Mountjoy Street, Londonderry

(b) Add the items set out in the Schedule to this Order.

(3) In Schedule 6 add the following item—

“30. Main Street, Dundrum (north-west side) – from a point 54 metres south-west of its junction with School Hill for a distance of 6 metres in a south-westerly direction.”

| 2848. | Northwood Road, Belfast (south-west side) – from a point 136 metres north west of its junction with Northwood Crescent for a distance of 6 metres in a north-westerly direction. |
| 2849. | Rochester Street, Belfast (south-west side) – from a point 44 metres south-east of its junction with Ravenhill Road for a distance of 5.5 metres in a south-easterly direction. |

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends The Parking Places (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) Order (Northern Ireland) 2016.

The amendments provide for the introduction of parking places with unlimited waiting on the lengths of the roads specified in the Schedule, the introduction of a parking place with limited waiting on the length of the road specified in Article 2(3) and the removal of the parking places referred to in Article 2(2)(a).
