**The Parking and Waiting Restrictions (Ballynahinch)
(Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2021**

Made - - - - - *24th June 2021*

Coming into operation - - - - - *19th July 2021*

The Department for Infrastructure^(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 4(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997^(b) and now vested in it^(c).

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 1 to that Order.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

No written objection or other representation has been received.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Parking and Waiting Restrictions (Ballynahinch) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2021 and shall come into operation on 19th July 2021.

Amendment

2. The Parking and Waiting Restrictions (Ballynahinch) Order (Northern Ireland) 2019^(d) is amended by the addition to Schedule 2 of the following item—

“27. Lisburn Street (north-east side) – from a point 159 metres south-east of its junction with Langley Road for a distance of 14.5 metres in a south-easterly direction.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order amends The Parking and Waiting Restrictions (Ballynahinch) Order (Northern Ireland) 2019 (“the Order”) by the addition to Schedule 2 of the item specified in Article 2 to this Order.

A penalty charge (£90) is payable with respect to a vehicle involved in a contravention of the Order in accordance with the Traffic Management (Northern Ireland) Order 2005 and The Penalty Charges (Prescribed Amounts) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006.

Traffic signs indicating the effect of this Order will in due course be placed on the road.
