**The M80/A80 Trunk Road (Lowwoods Southbound On Slip)
(Temporary 30mph Speed Restriction) Order 2010**

8th October 2010

Coming into force

25th October 2010

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 14(1) and (4), 2(1) and (2) and 4(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 14(1)(a) of that Act they are satisfied that the traffic on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to the Order should be restricted because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near those lengths of road.

In accordance with section 14(3) of that Act they have regard to the existence of alternative routes suitable for the traffic which will be affected by this Order.

Citation, commencement and cessation

1. This Order may be cited as the M80/A80 Trunk Road (Lowwoods Southbound On Slip) (Temporary 30mph Speed Restriction) Order 2010, comes into force on 25th October 2010 and ceases to have effect at midnight on 31st March 2011.

Temporary speed restriction

2. No person shall use, or permit the use of, any vehicle on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule at a speed exceeding 30mph when a restriction is identified as applying to any part or parts of that length of road by means of a traffic sign prescribed in Diagram 670 of the Traffic Signs Regulations(b).

The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by section 53 of the Scotland Act 1998 (c.46).

That length of the M80/A80 Glasgow-Stirling Trunk Road being the A80 Lowwoods southbound on slip from its junction with the A8011 Glasgow Road to its junction with the A80 Glasgow-Stirling Trunk Road, a distance of 450 metres or thereby.
