ROAD TRAFFIC

The A90 Trunk Road (Longhaven) (50mph Speed Limit) (Parttime 20mph Speed Limit) Order 2015

Made - - - 9th June 2015

Coming into force - - 17th June 2015

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 84(1)(a) and (c), and 124(1)(d) of and paragraph 27 of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section $84(2)(\mathbf{b})$ of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Scottish Ministers have given public notice of their intention to make the following Order, and have complied with Parts II and III of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(\mathbf{c}).

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the A90 Trunk Road (Longhaven) (50mph Speed Limit) (Parttime 20mph Speed Limit) Order 2015 and comes into force on 17th June 2015.

Speed restriction

- **2.**—(1) Subject to paragraph 2, no person may drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the length of road specified in part 1 of the Schedule to this Order.
- (2) No person may drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the length of road specified in part 2 of the Schedule to this Order, when such speed limit is indicated by means of a traffic sign prescribed in Diagram 670 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(**d**).

Revocation

3. The A90 Trunk Road (Longhaven Primary School) (Part-time 20mph Speed Limit) Order(e) is revoked.

4. No speed restriction imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(**a**) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.

SCHEDULE

Article 2

SPECIFIED LENGTH OF ROAD

PART 1

That length of the M90/A90 Edinburgh – Fraserburgh Trunk Road at Longhaven, from a point 230 metres or thereby north of the extended centreline of its northern junction with A975, northwards, to a point 760 metres or thereby north of the extended centreline of that junction with the A975, a distance of 530 metres or thereby.

PART 2

That length of the M90/A90 Edinburgh – Fraserburgh Trunk Road at Longhaven, from a point 409 metres or thereby north of the extended centreline of its northern junction with A975, northwards, to a point 575 metres or thereby north of the extended centreline of that junction with the A975, a distance of 166 metres or thereby.
