JUDGMENT

The judgment of the Tribunal is that:

- 1. All the claims that are made by the claimant in relation to harassment under the Equality Act 2010 and the application under the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974 are struck out for want of jurisdiction as they are made out of time.
- 2. It is not just and equitable to extend time in these circumstances.
- 3. With regard to the health and safety claims, it is also the case that claims under the 1974 Act are not within the jurisdiction of the Tribunal and are consequently struck out for that reason also.
