JUDGMENT

The Claimants' claims against the First and Second Respondents for unauthorised deduction from wages and failure to pay notice pay are dismissed upon withdrawal.

REASONS

- 1. These cases were listed for a full hearing. The First Respondent, Real Housing Foundation Limited, had not had a response accepted to either claim.
