JUDGMENT

The judgment of the Tribunal is as follows:

Wages

1. The complaint of unauthorised deductions from wages is well-founded. The respondent made unauthorised deductions from the claimant's wages in the period 19 April to 22 September 2023.
2. The respondent shall pay the claimant **£1130.35** (one thousand one hundred and thirty pounds and thirty-five pence), which is the gross sum deducted. The claimant is responsible for the payment of any tax or National Insurance.

Holiday Pay

3. The complaint in respect of holiday pay is well-founded. The respondent failed to pay the claimant in accordance with regulation 14(2) of the Working Time Regulations 1998.

4. The respondent shall pay the claimant **£364.60** (three hundred and sixty-four pounds and sixty pence). The claimant is responsible for paying any tax or National Insurance.
