Request:

The complainant requested the following information from Haringey London Borough Council on 4 March 2024:

"Q1 Please provide the number of tenants and leaseholders who pay each separate service charge, for the five years 2020/21, 2021/22, 2022/23, 2023/24, and 2024/25.

Please include supported housing in this information. Please use current estimates for the last two years, as appropriate. Please show the numbers of tenants and leaseholders separately.

Q2 Please provide the budget income from tenants, from leaseholders, and the total of both, for each separate service charge, for the five years 2020/21, 2021/22, 2022/23, 2023/24, and 2024/25, as above.

Q3 Please provide a full breakdown of service chargeable expenditure costs, for each of the five years, as above.

A small part of the above information (2023/24 tenant service charges: numbers paying and income received) has already been provided in response to an earlier FOI question, reference LBH 14498923. The object of the current request is to see all of the requested data over the 5 year period, as above.

Please provide your answer in a PDF, with the data in Excel form."

Commissioner's Decision:

A public authority will breach section 10 of FOIA if it fails to respond to a request within 20 working days. Based on evidence available to the Commissioner, by the date of this notice the public authority has not issued a substantive response to this request. Therefore the Commissioner finds a breach of section 10.

Steps:

The public authority must provide a substantive response to the request in accordance with its obligations under FOIA.

The public authority must take this step within 30 calendar days of the date of this decision notice. Failure to comply may result in the Commissioner making written certification of this fact to the High Court pursuant to section 54 of FOIA and may be dealt with as a contempt of court.

Right of Appeal:

Either party has the right to appeal against this decision notice to the First-tier Tribunal (Information Rights). Information about the appeals process may be obtained from:
