Their Lordships are of opinion that this Appeal should be allowed on the lines laid down by them in the case which has been referred to, of Musammat Izzat-un-nissa Begum and another v. Kunwar Pratab Singh and others (Privy Council Appeal No. 20 of 1908).

They will therefore humbly advise His Majesty to reverse the Decree of the High Court, and to restore the Decree of the Subordinate Judge with costs in both Courts against the first Respondent, the Plaintiff's successor in title.

The first Respondent will pay the costs of this Appeal.
