This appeal is covered by the decision of the Board in M. Takim and Compeny v. Fazal Kassam Velji. A different plaintiff buyer sues the same defendant for damages for failure to deliver goods under a contract of sale. The plaintiff relied on a document which it is conceded is similar in all relevant matters to that dealt with in the preceding appeal. The learned Judge following his decision in Takim's case awarded the plaintiff 20,000/- damages with costs and interest. The Court of Appeal after dealing with a preliminary point which was not pursued before the Board reversed his decision. For the reasons given in the preceding appeal their Lordships will humbly advise Her Majesty that this appeal be allowed the judgment of the Court of Appeal for Eastern Africa set aside with costs and the judgment of Gray, C.J., restored. The respondent must pay the costs of this appeal.
