CAP. LVII.

An Act to amend certain Provisions in "The Ecclesiastical Leasing Act, 1858."

[29th June 1865.]

HEREAS Doubts have arisen as to the Interpretation of certain Provisions of the Ecclesiastical Leasing Act, 21 & 22 Vict. 1858: Be it enacted by the Queen's most Excellent c. 57. Majesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority of the same, as follows, viz.:

1.
