ROAD TRAFFIC

The A66 Trunk Road (Thorpe Grange to Rokeby) (Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2010

Made - - - - *13 September 2010*
Coming into force - - *26 September 2010*

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A66 Trunk Road, in the County of Durham, is satisfied that traffic on that trunk road should be restricted because woodland enhancement works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A66 Trunk Road (Thorpe Grange to Rokeby) (Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 26 September 2010.
2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order no person shall, during the period starting at 00:01 hours on Monday 27 September 2010 and ending when the said works have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour in the A66 Trunk Road westbound carriageway from a point 490 metres east of the centreline of Thorpe Grange Junction westwards for a distance of 2450 metres.
3. The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes, or anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer in uniform.
