**The A66 Trunk Road (Scotch Corner to Greta Bridge) (Temporary
10 Miles Per Hour and 40 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order
2010**

Made - - - - - *22 November 2010*

Coming into force - - - - - *5 December 2010*

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A66 Trunk Road, in the Counties of Durham and North Yorkshire, is satisfied that traffic on that trunk road should be restricted because road stud replacement works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A66 Trunk Road (Scotch Corner to Greta Bridge) (Temporary 10 Miles Per Hour and 40 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 5 December 2010.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order no person shall, during a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 6 December 2010 or any subsequent night thereafter until the said works have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven in the A66 Trunk Road from its junction with Scotch Corner Interchange roundabout westwards for a distance of 12000 metres at a speed exceeding:

- (a) 10 miles per hour whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under Section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on those carriageways are displayed; or
- (b) 40 miles per hour whilst such traffic signs in relation to those carriageways are not displayed.

3. The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes, or anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer in uniform.
