ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A1(M) Motorway (Junction 16 Norman Cross,
Peterborough, City of Peterborough) Slip Roads (Temporary
Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

Made - - - - *24th May 2011*

Coming into force - - *31st May 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1(M) Motorway (“the A1(M)”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on some of those connecting roads in the City of Peterborough should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed nearby:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A1(M) Motorway (Junction 16 Norman Cross, Peterborough, City of Peterborough) Slip Roads (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 31st May 2011.

2. In this Order –

“works” means bridge inspection works;

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Wednesday 1st June 2011 or on any subsequent day until the works have been completed;

“a slip road” means the A1(M) Junction 16 –

(a) northbound exit slip road leading to, and

(b) southbound entry slip road leading from,

the A15/B1043 Norman Cross Interchange;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the works, or for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or traffic officer purposes.
