ROAD TRAFFIC

The A47 Trunk Road (Hockering, Norfolk) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) (No. 2) Order 2011

Made - - - - 20th June 2011

Coming into force - - 27th June 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A47 Trunk Road (“the A47”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road in the County of Norfolk should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A47 Trunk Road (Hockering, Norfolk) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) (No. 2) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 27th June 2011.

2. In this Order -

“the trunk road” means the A47 between points 750 metres east and 750 metres west of the centre line of its junction with the C157 The Street at Hockering;

“works” mean carriageway resurfacing and road marking works to the trunk road;

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 4th July 2011 or on any subsequent day until the works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6 no person shall, during a works period, drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding -

(a) 10 miles per hour on a length of the trunk road whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Traffic Road Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on those lengths are displayed, or

(b) 40 miles per hour on a length of the trunk road whilst such traffic signs, as specified at (a) above, in relation to those lengths are not displayed.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6 no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to -

(a) overtake any other moving vehicle on the trunk road, or

(b) enter or leave the trunk road at its junction with the C157 The Street at Hockering.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs.

6. The provisions of article 4 shall not apply to a vehicle –

- (a) being used for, or in connection with, the works,
- (b) being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes, or
- (c) proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform;

and nothing in article 3 shall apply to a vehicle being used for a purpose specified in paragraph (b) of this article or a vehicle falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011^(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
