ROAD TRAFFIC

The A31 Trunk Road and the M27 Motorway (M27 Junction 1 – Ashley Heath Interchange, Westbound) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

Made - - - - *8th August 2011*

Coming into force - - *27th August 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A31 Trunk Road, the M27 Motorway and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of those roads and on one of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A31 Trunk Road and the M27 Motorway (M27 Junction 1 – Ashley Heath Interchange, Westbound) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 27th August 2011.

2. In this Order:

“the A31” and “the M27” mean, respectively, the A31 Trunk Road and the M27 Motorway in the County of Hampshire;

“the length of carriageway” means the westbound carriageway of the M27 and the A31 between the westbound exit slip road at Junction 1 (B3079) and Ashley Heath Interchange (A338);

“the slip road” means the road leading to the westbound carriageway of the A31 from the roundabout at Junction 1 (B3079);

“works” mean carriageway repairs and all associated work on the A31 and the M27; and

“a works period” means a period of 8 hours starting at 2200 hours on Tuesday 30th August 2011 or on any subsequent day until 26th February 2013.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of carriageway or the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

(a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;

(b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1.

- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes; or
- (e) a vehicle proceeding in the length of carriageway to or from premises accessible from, and only from, that carriageway, to such extent as shall be indicated by traffic signs.
