**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A590 Trunk Road (Barrowbanks, Newby Bridge)  
(Prohibition of Traffic Movements) Order 2011**

*Made* - - - - - *13th September 2011*

*Coming into force* - - - - - *17th September 2011*

The Secretary of State for Transport makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 1(1), 2(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic regulation Act 1984(a):

1. This Order may be cited as The A590 Trunk Road (Barrowbanks, Newby Bridge) (Prohibition of Traffic Movements) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 17th September 2011.
2. In this Order:  
  
“the trunk road” means the A590 Trunk Road in the District of South Lakeland in the County of Cumbria;  
  
“the former field access” means the former field access located to the east of the trunk road, giving access to the trunk road from the redundant length of the former A590 Trunk Road, and situated 200 metres southeast of the junction of the trunk road with Back Lane.
3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter, leave or cross the trunk road by means of traffic movements to or from the former field access.
