**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A5 Trunk Road (Old Stratford, Northamptonshire)  
(Derestriction) Order 2011**

*Made* - - - - 14th February 2011  
*Coming into force* - - 28th February 2011

The Secretary of State for Transport in exercise of the powers conferred by section 82(2) and 83(1) of, and paragraph 27(1) of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the A5 Trunk Road (Old Stratford, Northamptonshire) (Derestriction) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 28th February 2011.

2. The length of the A5 Trunk Road at Old Stratford in the County of Northamptonshire, from a point 73 metres northwest of its roundabout junction with the A508, A422 and Towcester Road, known as Stratford Roundabout, to and including the circulatory carriageway of that roundabout, shall cease to be a restricted road for the purposes of section 81 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

3. Any previous order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or any enactment replaced by that Act which provided that the trunk road or any part thereof should cease to be a restricted road is amended by excluding any reference to the lengths of trunk road described in article 2 of this order.
