**The A1 Trunk Road (Markham Moor, Nottinghamshire)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

Made - - - - 14th May 2012

Coming into force - - 21st May 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1 Trunk Road (“the A1”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and two of those connecting roads, at Markham Moor in the County of Nottinghamshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The A1 Trunk Road (Markham Moor, Nottinghamshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 21st May 2012.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the northbound carriageway of the A1 from its junction with the slip road leading to the roundabout junction with the B1164 and Main Street to its junction with the slip road leading from that roundabout, at Markham Moor;

“a slip road” means the slip road leading -

- i) from the northbound carriageway of the A1 to the roundabout junction with the B1164 and Main Street at Markham Moor; and
- ii) from the southbound carriageway of the A1 to the roundabout junction with the A638 and A57 at Markham Moor.

“the works period” means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 28th May 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road or a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works.
