ROAD TRAFFIC

The A1(M) Motorway (Junction 45 to Junction 42) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

Made - - - - 14th June 2012

Coming into force - - 24th June 2012

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1(M) Motorway and connecting roads, in the Districts of Leeds and Selby, in the Counties of West Yorkshire and North Yorkshire, is satisfied that traffic on that motorway and some of those connecting roads should be prohibited because carriageway resurfacing, lining, traffic loop reinstallation and general maintenance works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A1(M) Motorway (Junction 45 to Junction 42) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 24th June 2012.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order, no person shall, during a period of 9 hours starting at 21:00 hours on Monday 25th June 2012 or any subsequent night thereafter until the said works have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A1(M) Motorway:

- (i) southbound carriageway from the nose of the southbound exit slip road at Junction 45 (Boston Spa) to the nose of the southbound entry slip road at Junction 44 (Bramham), a distance of 8000 metres;
- (ii) southbound carriageway from its junction with the M1 Motorway southbound carriageway at Hook Moor (the A1(M) Motorway Junction 43, M1 Motorway Junction 48) to the nose of the southbound entry slip road at Junction 42 (Selby Fork), a distance of 7200 metres;
- (iii) southbound entry slip road at Junction 45; or
- (iv) southbound exit or entry slip roads at Junction 44.

3. The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for winter maintenance or traffic officer purposes; or
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform.
