ROAD TRAFFIC

The A50 Trunk Road (Uttoxeter to Sudbury) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

Made - - - - 25th June 2012

Coming into force - - 2nd July 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A50 Trunk Road (“the A50”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on that road and one of those connecting roads, between Uttoxeter and Sudbury in the Counties of Derbyshire and Staffordshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The A50 Trunk Road (Uttoxeter to Sudbury) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 2nd July 2012.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the eastbound carriageway of the A50 from its roundabout junction with A518 north east of Uttoxeter to its junction with the slip road leading from the roundabout junction with the A515 west of Sudbury;

“the slip road” means the slip road leading from the westbound carriageway of the A50 to the roundabout junction with the A515 at Junction 8, west of Sudbury;

“the works period” means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Friday 6th July 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the trunk road or the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works.
