**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A30 Trunk Road (Okehampton Laybys) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

*Made* - - - - 23rd August 2012

*Coming into force* - - 31st August 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A30 Trunk Road (“the A30”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road near Okehampton in the Borough of West Devon in the County of Devon should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A30 Trunk Road (Okehampton Laybys) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 31st August 2012.

2. In this Order –

“layby” means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles, bounded partly by a road marking on the outer edge of that carriageway complying with diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(b); and in this definition “carriageway” means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a surface suitable for the exercise of that right;

“the works” mean culvert maintenance works;

“the works period” means the period starting at 00.01 hours on Sunday 2nd September 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter, proceed or remain in the layby adjacent to:

- (a) the eastbound carriageway of the A30 situated 480 metres west of the centre of the Willey Lane Overbridge;
- (b) the eastbound carriageway of the A30 situated 1160 metres west of the centre of the Tongue End Cross Junction Overbridge;

- (c) the westbound carriageway of the A30 situated 470 metres west of the centre of the Willey Lane Overbridge;
- (d) the westbound carriageway of the A30 situated 720 metres east of the centre of the Willey Lane Overbridge;
- (e) the westbound carriageway of the A30 situated 400 metres east of the centre of the Ring Hill Cross Overbridge.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
- (c) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works.
