**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Old Warden)
Regulations 2012**

Made - - - *7th September 2012*

Coming into force - - *7th October 2012*

The Secretary of State deems it necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Shuttleworth (Old Warden) Aerodrome, Bedfordshire, by reason of the holding of a flying display that is scheduled to take place there on 7th October 2012.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009(a).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Old Warden) Regulations 2012 and come into force on 7th October 2012.

Interpretation

2. In regulation 3 all times referred to are Co-ordinated Universal Time.

Restricted airspace

3.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), between 1245 hours and 1645 hours on 7th October 2012 no aircraft is to fly below 4,500 feet above mean sea level within the area of a circle having a radius of 3 nautical miles whose centre is at 520519N 0001906W.

(2) Paragraph (1) does not apply to any aircraft flying in accordance with the permission of the flying display director.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations impose restrictions on flying in airspace in the vicinity of Shuttleworth (Old Warden) Aerodrome, Bedfordshire, on the occasion of the “Cold War Jets” flying display to be held there on 7th October 2012. A number of civil and military aircraft will be involved in high energy manoeuvres during the event. The Civil Aviation Authority considers that restrictions should be imposed on flying in the vicinity of Shuttleworth (Old Warden) Aerodrome for reasons of public safety and this has been agreed with the Department for Transport.

Full details of the airspace restrictions will be promulgated by NOTAM.
