ROAD TRAFFIC

The A1 Trunk Road (Sandy, Bedfordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

Made - - - - *10th June 2013*

Coming into force - - *17th June 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1 Trunk Road (“the A1”), is satisfied that traffic on that road at Sandy in Central Bedfordshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed nearby:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A1 Trunk Road (Sandy, Bedfordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 17th June 2013.

2. In this Order –

“works” mean construction of a supermarket in Sandy;

“the works period” means the period starting at 08.00 hours on Monday 24th June 2013 and ending when the works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to leave the northbound carriageway or the southbound carriageway of the A1 at its junction with New Road, Sandy.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle –

(a) being used for, police, fire and rescue authority ambulance or traffic officer purposes, or

(b) proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a police constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
