### ROAD TRAFFIC

# The M1 Motorway (Junctions 22 to 23, Leicestershire) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2013

Made - - - - 9th September 2013

Coming into force - - 16th September 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M1 Motorway ("the M1"), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that motorway in the County of Leicestershire should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

**1.** This Order may be cited as the M1 Motorway (Junctions 22 to 23, Leicestershire) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 16th September 2013.

#### 2. In this Order:

"the motorway"

means -

- i) the southbound carriageway of the M1 from a point 200 metres north of the B591 Ingleberry Road overbridge (south of Junction 23) for a distance of 3000 metres in a southerly direction; and
- ii) the northbound carriageway of the M1 from a point 350 metres north of the B591 Copt Oak Road overbridge (north of Junction 22) to the centreline of Charley Road underbridge;

"the works period"

means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 23rd September 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the motorway.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to any vehicle
  - (a) being used for police, fire brigade, ambulance or special forces purposes; or
  - (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable.
