**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A46 and A1 Trunk Roads (Winthorpe, Newark-on-Trent,  
Nottinghamshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order  
2013**

*Made* - - - - 16th September 2013

*Coming into force* - - 23rd September 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A46 Trunk Road (“the A46”), the A1 Trunk Road (“the A1”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of the A46 and two of those connecting roads, at Winthorpe, near Newark-on-Trent in the County of Nottinghamshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A46 and A1 Trunk Roads (Winthorpe, Newark-on-Trent, Nottinghamshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 23rd September 2013.

2. In this Order –

“the trunk road”

means –

- i) the northbound carriageway of the A46 from the roundabout junction with the A616, A617 and the B6326 (Cattlemarket Roundabout) to the roundabout junction with the slip roads leading to and from the A1 and the B6166 Lincoln Road;
- ii) the southbound carriageway of the A46 from the roundabout junction with the slip roads leading to and from the A1 and the B6166 Lincoln Road to Cattlemarket Roundabout;

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- iii) the northbound carriageway of the A46 from the roundabout junction with the slip roads leading to and from the A1 and the B6166 Lincoln Road to the roundabout junction with the A17 and the slip roads leading to and from the A1;
- iv) the southbound carriageway of the A46 from the roundabout junction with the A17 and the slip roads leading to and from the A1 to the roundabout junction with the slip roads leading to and from the A1 and the B6166 Lincoln Road;
- v) the northbound carriageway of the A46 from the roundabout junction with the A17 and the slip roads leading to and from the A1 to the roundabout junction with the A1133 and Drove Lane (Winthorpe Roundabout);
- vi) the southbound carriageway of the A46 from Winthorpe Roundabout to its roundabout junction with the A17 and the slip roads leading to and from the A1; and
- vii) the southbound carriageway of the A46 from its junction with the exit slip road leading to Brough Lane at Brough to Winthorpe Roundabout;

“a slip road”

means the slip road leading –

- i) to the southbound carriageway of the A46 from its junction with Danethorpe Lane, Brough; and
- ii) from the southbound carriageway of the A1 to the roundabout junction with the A46 and A17;

“layby”

means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a road marking of the type shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002 (a) and partly by the outer edge of that carriageway on the same side of the road as that on which the marking is placed; and in this definition “carriageway” means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in a length of the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a suitable surface for the exercise of that right;

"the works period"

means the period starting at 12.00 hours on Monday 30th September 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the trunk road or a slip road.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in any layby situated adjacent to the trunk road.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (c) being used in connection with the said works.
