**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A453 Trunk Road (M1 Junction 24 to Parkway Station Junction) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013**

*Made* - - - - 24th November 2013

*Coming into force* - - 1st December 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A453 Trunk Road (“the A453”), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road between M1 Junction 24 and Parkway Station Junction, in the Counties of Leicestershire and Nottinghamshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) and 15(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A453 Trunk Road (M1 Junction 24 to Parkway Station Junction) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 1st December 2013.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the eastbound and westbound carriageways of the A453 from the roundabout junction with the M1 Junction 24 to the junction with Kegworth Road and the access road to Parkway Station;

“bicycle” means a pedal cycle with fewer than four wheels and not being a mechanically propelled vehicle;

“the works period” means the period starting at 00:01 hours on Monday 4th December 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any bicycle to enter or proceed in the trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any bicycle -

(a) being used for police purposes; or

(b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable.

5. The Secretary of State is satisfied that the execution of the said works will take longer than a period of eighteen months starting on the date when this Order comes into force.
