**The M5 Motorway (Junctions 2 to 3, Oldbury to Quinton)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014**

Made - - - - 8th April 2014

Coming into force - - 15th April 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M5 Motorway (“the M5”) is satisfied that traffic on a length of that motorway, in the West Midlands, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M5 Motorway (Junctions 2 to 3, Oldbury to Quinton) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Tuesday 15th April 2014.

2. In this Order:

| “the motorway” | means the –

a) northbound carriageway of the M5 from its junction with exit slip road at Junction 3, to its junction with the entry slip road at Junction 2; and

b) southbound carriageway of the M5 from its junction with the exit slip road at Junction 2, to its junction with the entry slip road at Junction 3; |
| “a slip road” | means the slip road leading to the –
a) northbound carriageway of the M5 at Junction 3;
and
b) southbound carriageway of the M5 at Junction 2; |
| “the works period” | means the period starting at 21:30 hours on Tuesday 22nd April 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed; |

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the motorway or a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (c) being used for or in connection with the said works or by a traffic officer in uniform.
