**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Ascot)
(Amendment) Regulations 2014**

Made - - - - *14th July 2014*

Coming into force - - *14th August 2014*

The Secretary of State has decided that it is necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Ascot, Berkshire, by reason of the Red Bull Air Race that is scheduled to take place there during the period from 14th to 17th August 2014.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009^(a).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Ascot) (Amendment) Regulations 2014 and come into force on 14th August 2014.

Amendment

2. The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Ascot) Regulations 2014^(b) are amended as follows.

3. In regulation 3(2)(b)(ii), for “512632N 0003552W” substitute “512634N 0003552W”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Ascot) Regulations 2014 (S.I. 2014/1558) (“the principal Regulations”). The amendment corrects an error in one of the coordinates specifying the boundary of the area which is subject to the flying restrictions imposed by the principal Regulations during the period from 14th to 17th August 2014.
