**The M6 Motorway (Junctions 40-42 Northbound Carriageway
and Junction 41 Northbound Entry Slip Road) (Temporary
Restriction of Traffic) Order 2014**

Made - - - - *28th August 2014*

Coming into force - - *31st August 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport being the traffic authority for the M6 Motorway and its slip roads is satisfied that traffic on a section of that motorway and on one of those slip roads in the District of Eden in the County of Cumbria, should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M6 Motorway (Junctions 40-42 Northbound Carriageway and Junction 41 Northbound Entry Slip Road) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 31st August 2014.

2. In this Order:

“the motorway” means the M6 Motorway between Junctions 40 and 42;

“the length of carriageway” means the northbound carriageway of the motorway from a point 590 metres south of the centreline of Petheril Bridge to a point 1470 metres north of the centreline of Plumpton Bridge;

“the slip road” means the entry slip road leading to the northbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 41;

“works” means drainage works on the motorway;

“the works period” means a period starting at 0001 hours on Monday 1st September 2014 and ending at 2359 hours on Sunday 9th November 2014. However, work may start and continue beyond these dates for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven in the length of carriageway or the slip road at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour.
4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance services or anything done at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
5. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 (a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
