ROAD TRAFFIC

The A47 Trunk Road (A140 Ipswich Road Interchange to A146 Trowse Interchange, Norwich, Norfolk) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - 22nd September 2014

Coming into force - - 29th September 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A47 Trunk Road (“the A47”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road and on some of those connecting roads, in the County of Norfolk, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A47 Trunk Road (A140 Ipswich Road Interchange to A146 Trowse Interchange, Norwich, Norfolk) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 29th September 2014.

2. In this Order –

“tip of the nosing” means, as indicated by the markings on the carriageway, the first point where an entry slip road joins, or the last point where an exit slip road leaves, the carriageway of the trunk road;

“the trunk road” means the-

- (a) eastbound carriageway of the A47 between the tips of nosings of the exit slip road at A140 Ipswich Road Interchange and the entry slip road at A146 Trowse Interchange, and
- (b) westbound carriageway of the A47 between the tips of the nosings of the exit slip road at A146 Trowse Interchange and the entry slip road at A140 Ipswich Road Interchange;

“a slip road” means the –

- (a) entry slip road to the eastbound carriageway of the A47 at the A140 Ipswich Road Interchange, and
- (b) entry slip road to the westbound carriageway of the A47 at the A146 Trowse Interchange;

“works” mean carriageway resurfacing, renewal of road markings and expansion joint repairs to the A47 River Tas Bridge the A47 A140 Ipswich Road Interchange bridge and the A47 A146 Trowse Interchange bridge;

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1 (1) and Schedule 1.

“a works period” means a period of 9 hours starting at 21.00 hours on Monday 6th October 2014 or on any subsequent day (other than a Saturday or Sunday) until the works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road or a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle -

- (a) being used for, or in connection with, the works or for traffic officer or winter maintenance purposes,
- (b) being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes, or
- (c) proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
