**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A2070 Trunk Road (A2042 Junction, Slip Roads)  
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014**

*Made* - - - - *24th November 2014*  
*Coming into force* - - *17th December 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A2070 Trunk Road and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on some of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A2070 Trunk Road (A2042 Junction, Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 17th December 2014 and shall apply for a period of twelve months.

**2.** In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A2070 Trunk Road south of Ashford in the County of Kent;

“a slip road” means –

- (i) the road leading from the northbound carriageway of the trunk road to the westbound carriageway of the A2042 (Park Farm junction),
- (ii) the road leading from the westbound carriageway of the trunk road to the southbound carriageway of the trunk road (Park Farm junction),
- (iii) the road leading from the eastbound carriageway of the A2042 to the southbound carriageway of the trunk road (Park Farm junction), or
- (iv) the road leading from the northbound carriageway of the trunk road to the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road (Park Farm junction);

“works” means cyclic maintenance and/or urgent repair work on the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of 9 hours starting at 2000 hours on Wednesday 17th December 2014 or on any subsequent day until Wednesday 16th December 2015.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a slip road.

**4.** The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to –

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;

- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
