**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A30 Trunk Road (Carland Cross Roundabout, Cornwall)  
(Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014**

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A30 Trunk Road (“the A30”), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road near Truro in Cornwall should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A30 Trunk Road (Carland Cross Roundabout, Cornwall) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 22nd February 2014.

**2.** In this Order –

“the first length of the A30” means the A30 from a point 300 metres west of the western edge of the Carland Cross Roundabout to a point 300 metres east of the eastern edge of that roundabout;

“the second length of the A30” means the A30 from the centre of its junction with the B3285 Boxheater Junction to the western edge of the Carland Cross Roundabout;

“the third length of the A30” means the A30 from a point at the centre of the A3076 Mitchell Junction to a point at the eastern edge of the Carland Cross Roundabout;

“the circulatory carriageway” means sections of the circulatory carriageway at the A30 / A39 Carland Cross Roundabout;

“the works” mean maintenance activities including traffic sign, road marking and surfacing works;

“a works period” means a period of 11 hours starting at 19.00 hours on Monday 24th February 2014 or on any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 4, 5 and 6, no person shall, during a works period:

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(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1.

- (a) drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour on the first length of the A30 whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on that road are displayed;
- (b) drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the second length of the A30;
- (c) drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the third length of the A30;
- (d) cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the circulatory carriageway.

**4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of a constable.

**5.** The provisions of article 3(d) shall not apply to a vehicle being used in connection with the said works, for winter maintenance purposes or for traffic officer purposes.

**6.** No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
