The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Northampton Sywell) (Amendment) Regulations 2021

Made - - - -at 14.00 p.m. on 2nd September 2021

Coming into force - - - -with immediate effect

The Secretary of State has previously decided that it is in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Northampton Sywell Aerodrome, by reason of the intended holding of the Light Aircraft Association Rally 2021.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 239 of the Air Navigation Order 2016^(a).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Northampton Sywell) (Amendment) Regulations 2021 and they come into force with immediate effect.

Amendment

2.—(1) The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Northampton Sywell) Regulations 2021^(b) are amended as follows.

(2) In regulation 3 add ‘(3) Paragraph (1) does not apply to any aircraft — (a) flying in accordance with a permission issued by Sywell Aeronautical Ground Communications.’
